Background: I have an idea that I would like to present to the board at our next meeting.

About a year ago I had asked about the possibility of the buses collecting food for the food bank. There seemed to be some interest in that, but nothing ever happened. I understand that logistically this would be difficult assuming that the drivers would not have anywhere to drop the items off at the end of their shift.

The idea I have involves the donation boxes. What if SPOT sponsored a local charity each month that would receive whatever donations collected for that month? We don't receive a significant amount of donations, so I don't see that it would have a huge impact on SPOT's finances. However, if people see that the funds were going towards a local cause, they might donate more. Similar to how Winter Ridge choses various charities each month to receive your bag donations. We could randomly select the charities at each meeting for the next month, put it on our website, place a flyer on the donation box, and get some free press in the paper each month. It would mean that we would need to empty the donation boxes monthly, which we should be doing anyway.

I am a firm believer that every business needs to give back to their community. Please consider putting this on November's agenda if you think that the board might consider doing this.
