MINUTES: Approve minutes of the July 20, 2023 regular meeting as presented.

Motion to approve the minutes of the July 20, 2023 regular meeting. Zale Palmer/Ron Smith. All in favor. Approved

#### **FINANCIAL REPORTS:**

Accept Financial Reports for July.

Motion to accept the financial reports for July. Zale Palmer/ Clif Warren. All in favor. Approved Year-to-date actual is under budget.

Approve payment of prepaid bills and outstanding bills, with additional of bills from Schweitzer and Lake City

Motion to approve the payment of prepaid bills and outstanding bills, as amended. Zale Palmer/Ron Smith. All in favor. Approved

#### **STAFF REPORTS:**

**Ridership:** Donna Griffin reported that ridership for Boundary County was very low for the month of July, but early numbers for August show improvement. Working on various options for additional ridership. Festival at Sandpoint ridership for this year was 4,374 in comparison to 2,068 in the prior year. Fall Fest ridership also saw an increase from 494 last year to 628 this year. Demand/Para Transit received 12 new applications in the last 3 weeks. Donna reported receiving ridership requests from Luther Park and other locations where people might have other transportation options.

**Operations:** Donna Griffin reported six of the 10 benches have been built and installed. There are two benches still in the storage unit, which will be cleared out and surrendered by end of August. Brandon with City of Sandpoint has been very helpful issuing specs for pads. Ponderay might be able to use the same specs. Ponderay is setting aside some space for SPOT at the Home Depot expansion. Product recalls relating to the fuel rail have been received on four of the five Mountain Buses. Donna is reaching out to Bryson on the recalls on the newer buses. All buses must be back in service by Fall Fest. Especially the newer buses to make sure they are operating properly before ski season. The 2024/2026 grant cycle will be open October 2, 2023 through January 2024. Looking into extending other open grants that will be expiring September 30, 2023: Microtransit, technology, and marketing grants.

#### **COMMITTEE REPORTS:**

- **A. Boundary County Service Development Committee:** Ron Smith reported City of Moyie Springs has agreed to provide match in the amount of \$1,000 for this year and next year.
- B. Finance Committee Update: The financial reports were reviewed and approved. A presentation was made to City of Sandpoint on August 2, 2023. Sandpoint has requested that SPOT develop a methodology for allocating the match funds. No response from Bonner County commissioners after their presentation. Although the County stated they may be able to help in other areas, even if non-monetary. Finance committee also discussed setting up an equipment replenishment cycle. Need to plan on how to fund the matches for future capital expenditures in addition to the regular matches. Discussed if we should use Cares Funds or 5311 funds for July-September 2023. Per Shauna, we can extend the Cares Funds if not used by 2025. They will also have a one-time Cares grant offered in October 2023 to be used for any need. The Finance Committee recommends that we use Cares Funds for the remainder of this current fiscal year.

#### **ACTION & DISCUSSION ITEMS:**

- A. Action Item: SPOT Authority User Information and Policy, and Paratransit Demand Application. Staff has been working on revamping the application and user policy. Also making the application easier to complete. Board discussed possible changes and corrections to application and user policy.
  Tabled. No action taken.
- B. Action Item: Ponderay Neighbor Day, Saturday September 9, 2023. SPOT has been asked if we want a booth and staff at this event, along with a bus. \$50 fee. City of Ponderay would appreciate if we would participate. Gary Kunzeman recommended that we have a booth.
   Motion to secure a booth at the Ponderay Neighbor Days event. Zale Palmer/ Ron Smith. All in favor.
- C. Action Item: Bonner County EMS Revised SPOT Bus MOU. The attorney added additional verbiage to the agreement. The County is reviewing the changes.
  Tabled. No action taken.
- **D.** Action Item: Transloc agreement extension to December 2023. Transloc has agreed to extend our use of the old system through December 2023 at an increased cost \$700 up from \$609. Donna is still looking to switch over to Paseo.
  - Motion to extend the Transloc agreement through December 31, 2023. Clif Warren/ Zale Palmer. All in favor. Approved.
- E. Action Item: Public Transportation Summit September 26-28, 2023. This year's event will be the precursor to next year's that will be open to stakeholders and everyone interested in public transportation. This year's summit will mainly be a planning session for next year's. Cost to attend will be covered by RTAP, up to two members. This year's event will be held in Boise. Next year's to be held in Sun Valley.

- F. Action Item: Proposed budget and financial considerations.

  Motion to publish the proposed budget for 2023/2024. Clif Warren/ Ron Smith. All in favor. Approved.

  Motion to submit July through September grant funding invoices under the Care Act grant. Clif Warren/ Zale Palmer. All in favor. Approved.

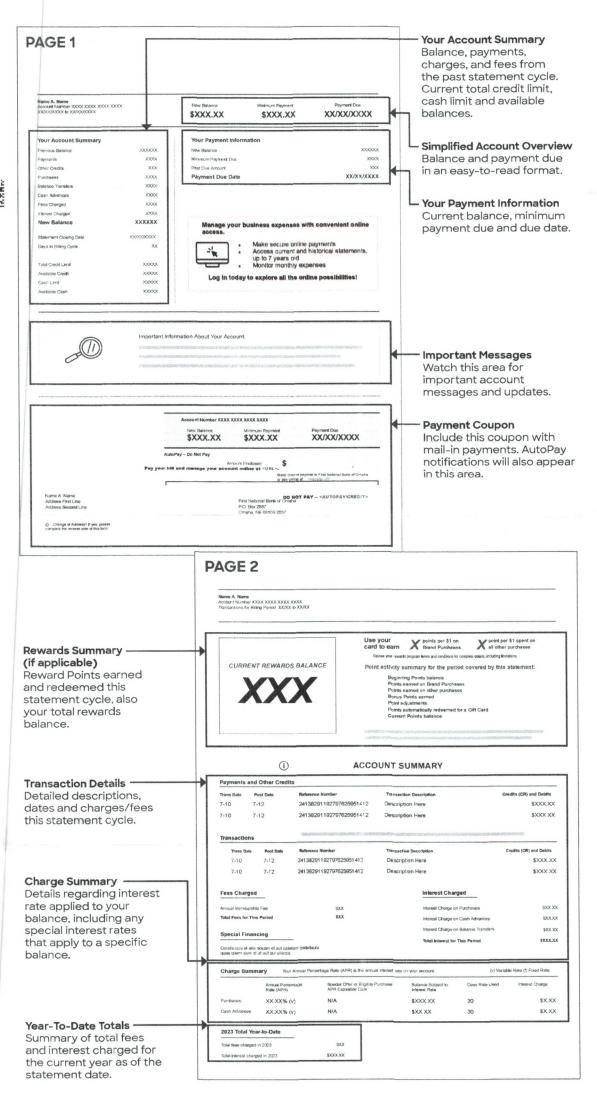
