#### **FINANCIAL REPORTS:**

Approve payment of prepaid bills and outstanding bills.

Motion to approve payment of prepaid bills and outstanding bills. Zale Palmer/ Ron Smith. All in favor. Approved

#### **STAFF REPORTS:**

**Ridership:** Donna Griffin reported that Fixed Route ridership is good, especially for the route from Schweitzer Apartments to the Red Barn. Para Transit was a bit low for January, but up from December 2023. New cards are being printed for Boundary County reflecting the new schedule. Posters are also being prepared to place in the bus shelter to promote ridership. The Mountain Route had 15,000 riders in December 2023 and 21,000 riders in January 2024. Only a 500 difference in ridership from January 2023, even with bad conditions this winter.

**Operations:** Donna Griffin reported the Mountain buses are still a struggle to keep running. Usually only 2-3 buses available on a given day. Sometimes Schweitzer is deciding to run their own buses instead of ours. Not sure that is being communicated to management. New mountain buses are incurring costly repairs that are not covered under warranty – classified as wear and tear. Also incurring costly repairs with the older fixed route buses. The used 2017 buses we acquired are running great and are a great asset. The local repair shops are really stepping up in getting buses worked on quickly.

#### **COMMITTEE REPORTS:**

- **A. Boundary County Service Development Committee:** Ron Smith reported he is working on getting the Herald's reporter to ride the bus and put a write up in the paper.
- **B.** Finance Committee: The financial reports for January were reviewed and approved. Repairs for January were over budget, but as a whole year-to-date we are under budget year-to-date. ITD has been slow in paying grant funding invoices. City of Ponderay still owes their match. Discussed the new national grant program.

#### **ACTION & DISCUSSION ITEMS:**

#### A. Action Item: SPOT Employee Incident Policy.

Having some issues with drivers not reporting incidents timely. Discussed what would be considered as an "incident". Need to also have an incident form for passenger injury. **See below for combined action taken.** 

#### B. Action Item: Establish a SPOT Bus Incident Advisory Board.

Committee needs to be formed. Suggested including Kevin (mechanic), Donna, Wendy, and a rotating driver. Committee to report to the board. **See below for combined action taken.** 

#### C. Action Item: Establish a SPOT Bus Safety Committee.

Discussed in general.

Motion to proceed with process to incorporate items a-c into the employee manual with modifications discussed. Clif Warren/ Nancy Lewis. All in favor. Approved.

#### D. Action Item: Demand Bus Order.

The original grant was issued for 5 buses – we have only received the 2 mountain buses so far. Still waiting for the 2 fixed route buses and 1 demand bus. The WA contract has been voided. The attorney is still reviewing the GA contract. Would like to see the dispute jurisdiction changed from GA to ID. Attorney says it's a good contract even without the change in jurisdiction. ITD has pledged an additional \$70,000 in grant funds towards these buses. Grant balances were reviewed and determined there is \$471,000 in grant funds available for these remaining 3 buses. **No action taken.** 

#### E. Action Item: Grant Opportunity – Rural 5339 for Low or No Emission Vehicles and for Buses and Bus Facilities.

There is a new federal grant opportunity that will be handled through ITD. \$1.6 Billion available country-wide. ITD wants to know if we are interested. Would be good to apply for facilities program. Need to have a property identified. **No action taken.** 

#### F. Action Item: Fixed Routes.

Reviewed various maps of portions of the fixed routes. Wendy identified various changes in stop locations for better traffic flow and adding stops for new hotel and Envision Center.

Motion to make changes as presented excluding the stop for the new hotel. Clif Warren/ Zale Palmer. All in favor. Approved.

#### G. Action Item: Financial Considerations.

Accept Financial Reports for January.

Motion to accept the financial reports for January. Clif Warren/ Zale Palmer. All in favor. Approved

#### **AMENDMENT 5**

#### Recitals

WHEREAS Company and Customer entered into that certain Technology License and Service Agreement as of February 21, 2017 (the "Agreement");

WHEREAS the Agreement was amended to expire on December 31, 2023 (the "Amendment 4"); and


