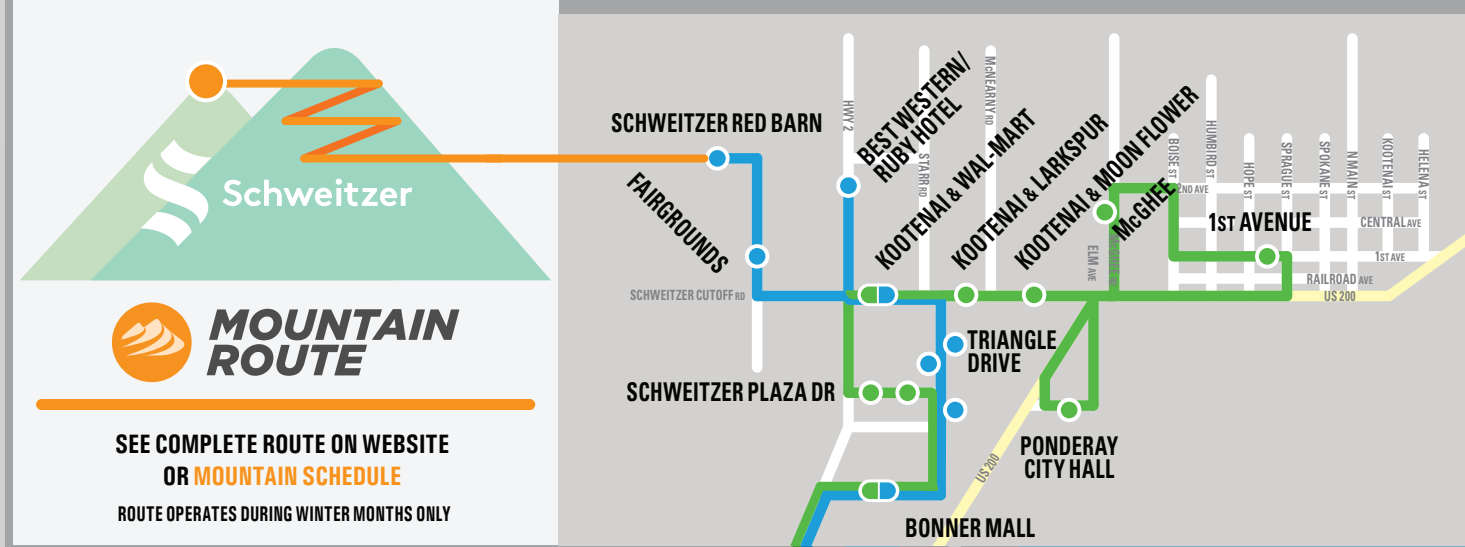

RIDER POLICIES AND REGULATIONS

Busess stay on published routes and will only board passengers at designated stops.

All times are approximate. Please be standing at your stop 5 minutes prior to the scheduled time.

All times are subject to change. Schedules are posted throughout the area and are available online.

No smoking within 25 feet of the bus.

No consumption of food or beverages on the bus.

Devices which play music or make sound may only be used with earphones or headphones.

Disruptive behavior, profanity, or vulgar language may result in removal from the bus.

Children under 6 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

Service animals are welcome. Pets may not ride the bus.

Bags, luggage, backpacks, etc. must be safely stowed in the luggage area or under your seat.

The use of bicycle racks is on a first-come, first-serve basis. Riders are responsible for securing their own bikes in the bike racks. Fat tire bikes will not fit on the bike racks.

Shoes and shirts are required.

SPOT reserves the right to refuse service.

SPOT is ADA compliant and provides paratransit services for qualifying persons.
